
Dear Regional Hearing Clerk,

Hi Vanessa,

I wanted to let you know that I received your mother's financial information. Thank you for getting it to me. We will have our financial analysts review it as quickly as possible. In the meantime, I encourage you to file a motion for extension of time to file your answer so that your mother doesn't end up in default and owing the full amount. If you ask for a reasonable amount of time (e.g., 30 days) the government will not object.
