Dear Mr. and Mrs. Landis:

On May 16, 2011, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Administrative Order, Docket No. SDWA-08-2011-0041, ordering you, as owners of the Rocky Mountain Lodge public water system, to comply with various regulations issued by EPA under the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), 42 U.S.C. § 300f et seq.

Our records indicate that you (Respondents) are in violation of the Administrative Order (the Order). Among other things, the Order included the following requirements (quoted from item 9 of the Order section on page 2 of the Order):

 Respondents shall monitor the system's water quarterly for total coliform bacteria, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.21. Respondents shall report analytical results to EPA within the first 10 days following the month in which sample results were received, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.31(a). Respondents shall report any violation of the total coliform monitoring requirements to EPA within 10 days of discovery, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.21(g)(2). Respondents did not monitor for total coliform bacteria during the first quarter (January - March) of 2012.

EPA is considering additional enforcement action as a result of the noncompliance with the Order. Violating an Administrative Order may lead to (1) a penalty of up to \$37,500 per day per violation of the Order, and/or (2) a court injunction ordering compliance.
