Dear Mr. Roubin:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the Administrative Compliance Order on Consent (AOC) referenced above which was issued to Roubin and Janeiro, Inc. The AOC required site updates, including the submission of an updated Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). The Respondent has submitted the required documentation and the period of oversight has concluded; therefore, the AOC is hereby terminated.

Please note that Respondents must still comply with any applicable Clean Water Act (CWA) requirements or applicable National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. Any noncompliance with the CWA or a current or future NPDES permit could result in the initiation of an additional enforcement action pursuant to the Federal enforcement provisions set forth in Section 309 of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. Section 1319. Permittees are therefore encouraged to pay close attention to all permit conditions, at all times, and to maintain any plans or Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) to assure compliance.
