Dear Mayor Perry:

This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Emergency Administrative Order (Emergency Order), issued on January 17, 2014 to the Town of Granger (Town). The EPA has determined that the Town has completed all actions outlined in EPA's January 17, 2014 Emergency Order and that the water provided by the Town of Granger public water system (System) no longer presents an imminent and substantial endangerment to persons served by the System. Therefore EPA will close the Emergency Order at this time.

Please be aware that the Town of Granger is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (NPDWR), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs may result in a court-imposed injunction and penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
