FINAL ORDER ASSESSING ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY

- 1. On February 1, 2010, Complainant filed a Complaint and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Complaint") against First Capital Insulation, Inc., and the School District of the City of York (hereinafter referred to as "Respondents"), for violations of Section 112 of the Clean Air Act ("CAA" or the "Act"), as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 7412.
- 2. The Complaint proposed the issuance of a Final Order Assessing Administrative

 Penalties in the amount of nine thousand nine hundred fourteen dollars (\$9,914.00)

 against Respondents, and indicated that this proposed penalty had been determined in accordance with in accordance with Section 113 of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. § 7413; 40

C.F.R. Part 19; U.S. EPA's Clean Air Act Stationary Source Civil Penalty Policy, dated October 25, 1992 ("CAA Penalty Policy"), and Appendix III thereto ("Asbestos Penalty Policy"); Modifications to EPA's Penalty Policies to Implement the Civil Monetary Penalty Inflation Rule (pursuant to the Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996), dated May 9, 1997 ("Inflation Policy"); and the most recent Inflation Policy dated December 29, 2008. The Complaint was issued pursuant to EPA the Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties, and the Revocation/Termination or Suspension of Permits ("Consolidated Rules"), set forth at 40 C.F.R. Part 22.

- Pursuant to Section 22.18(a)(1) of the Consolidated Rules, a Respondent may resolve a proceeding without the need to file an answer if the Complaint contains a specific proposed penalty and Respondent pays the proposed penalty in full within 30 days after receiving the Complaint, unless the Complaint seeks a compliance or corrective action order or Permit Action.
- 4. On February 24, 2010, Respondents submitted a check in the amount of \$9,914.00 (Check # 110253799) to the EPA lockbox in full payment of the specific penalty proposed in the Complaint. Respondents' check was received within thirty (30) days of service of the Complaint. The Complaint did not seek a compliance or corrective action order or Permit Action.

Section 22.18(a)(3) of the Consolidated Rules, the payment by Respondents constitutes a waiver of Respondents' rights to contest the allegations and to appeal this Final Order.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 22.18(a)(3) of the Consolidated Rules, it is hereby Ordered that Respondent is assessed an administrative penalty in the amount of \$9,914.00 and, payment having been made, this matter is concluded.
