EPA is seeking civil penalties for Aukerman's failure to prepare and maintain records regarding the land application of domestic septage, for failure to land apply at an agronomic application rate, and for violating the vector attraction reduction and pathogen reduction requirements.

**Description:** EPA requests public comment on the draft Operating Permit for Veolia Environmental Services (Permit No. V-IL-1716300103-08-01), a hazardous waste combustion facility.

Pursuant to the requirements of title V of the Clean Air Act and part 71, the permit contains emissions limitations and standards to assure compliance with all Clean Air Act requirements that apply to the source, as well as other necessary terms and conditions.
