

ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION

Despite EPA's representation that a settlement in principle was reached on March 7, 2008 and that the matter is "a straightforward cash settlement," and although more than a month and a half has since elapsed, EPA states that, it will still need an *additional* month and a half to draft the settlement and obtain the necessary signatures. Under the circumstances of the promised eventual effectuation of a settlement, the Court directed, during a conference call held on April 23, 2008, that a copy of the fully executed CAFO be delivered within six weeks from the date of this Order. That will allow EPA Counsel a quarter of a year after it announced reaching its settlement in principle to deliver the promised agreement. Should the agreement unravel, the parties are directed to inform the Court on the same day of such an occurrence, so that the Court may set the case for hearing.
