

EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 10 (EPA), by its duly delegated official, and by Excavators R Us ("Respondent") pursuant to Section 205(c)(1) of the Clean Air Act (CAA), 42 U.S.C. § 7524(c)(1), and 40 C.F.R. § 22.13(b).

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

On or about April 14 and April 25, 2025 an authorized representative of U.S. Customs and Border Protection conducted inspections to gather information in order to determine Respondent's compliance with Sections 203(a)(1) and 213(d) of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 7522(a)(1) and 7547(d), and the regulations codified at 40 C.F.R. § 1068.101(a)(1) and (b)(5). Based on that information, EPA has determined that Respondent violated the CAA and aforementioned regulations as noted on the enclosed "Description of Violations and Vehicles/Equipment" (Attachment 1), which is hereby incorporated by reference.

SETTLEMENT

In consideration of the penalty assessment factors set forth in Section 205(c)(2) of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. § 7524(c)(2), and upon consideration of the entire record, the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violations described in Attachment 1 for the total penalty amount of \$23,280.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. For purposes of this proceeding, Respondent waives any objections that it may have regarding jurisdiction; neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein and in Attachment 1; consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above; waives its rights to contest the allegations contained herein or in Attachment 1, to a hearing afforded by Section 205(c)(1) of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. § 7524(c)(1), and to appeal this ESA. Each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.
- 2. Respondent also certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that it has corrected the violations listed in Attachment 1.

- 4. Respondent agrees to submit payment in full of the penalty within 30 days of the filing of a fully executed copy of this ESA with the Regional Hearing Clerk.
- 5. Payment instructions are included on the enclosed "Payment Instructions" (Attachment 2), which is hereby incorporated by reference.
- 6. Failure to pay the penalty when due may subject Respondent to a civil action pursuant to Section 205(c)(6) of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. § 7524(c)(6), to collect the penalty, including accrued interest, attorney's fees, collection costs, and nonpayment penalties.
- 7. Upon Respondent's submission of the signed original ESA, signature by EPA, filing with the Regional Hearing Clerk and timely payment of the penalty, EPA will take no further civil penalty action against Respondent for the alleged violations of the CAA referenced in Attachment 1.
- 8. Nothing in this ESA shall affect the right of EPA or the United States to pursue appropriate injunctive or other equitable relief or criminal sanctions for any violations of law. This ESA does not waive, extinguish, or otherwise affect Respondent's obligations to comply with all applicable provisions of the CAA and regulations promulgated or permits issued thereunder.
- 9. This ESA is binding on the parties signing below.
- 10. This ESA is effective upon filing with the Regional Hearing Clerk.

Table 2 - Description of Violations and Vehicles/Equipment

Excavators R Us ("Respondent") imported the engines described at the bottom of Table 2 (the "Subject Engines") on or about April 14 and April 25, 2025. Authorized federal inspectors examined the Subject Engines. EPA reviewed the information provided by the importer and information collected by CBP Officers indicating that the Vehicles Emission Control Labels applied to the engines were not legitimate labels applied by the engine manufacturer and that the engines were not certified. EPA has found no further evidence indicating the Subject Engines are exempt or otherwise excluded from coverage under Title II the Clean Air Act (CAA) and its implementing regulations. Accordingly, by importing the Subject Engines, Respondent has committed 9 violations of CAA Section 203(a)(1) and 213(d), 42 U.S.C. §§ 7522(a)(1) and 7547(d), and the regulations codified at 40 C.F.R. § 1068.101(a)(1) and (b)(5).
