Mr. Lee, Ms. Barrientos and Ms. Sullivan;

I am in receipt of the Consent Agreement and Final Order for the above-referenced matter. Upon review, I noted that this CAFO does not comply with a provision of my June 19, 2020 Standing Order concerning the service of documents electronically. In particular, paragraph 2 on page 4 of the Standing Order states, in relevant part, that “[a] party who consents to electronic notice shall file an acknowledgement of its consent, identifying the type of electronic means agreed to and the electronic address to be used, with the Regional Hearing Clerk. [emphasis added].” See *In Re Charles*

Bridge, LLC, TSCA Appeal No. 23-03, Order Exercising Sue Sponte Review and Remanding to Presiding Officer for Further Proceedings at p. 4 (“upon remand the RJO must confirm that service [...] via email complies with the CROP and the Region’s [June 19, 2020] Standing Order on electronic service and that proper service is demonstrated in the record.”).

In accordance with paragraph 2 on page 4 of the June 19, 2020 Standing Order, Respondent must file an acknowledgment with the Regional Hearing Clerk that specifies the electronic address of the person who will accept electronic service on behalf of Respondent.
