**Introduction**: The Presiding Officer requested that the parties' attorneys provide an update on efforts to resolve this matter.

**Status:** It appears that Respondent needs to gather specific details to update the SEP proposal and work out the final terms and conditions of the Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO). There has been a delay in gathering information on topography, soil, etc.but the Respondent has determined the number of residences that are going to be connected.
