Dear Messrs. Alm and Kovacs:

On February 28, 2012, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Administrative Order (Order) ordering Paint Rock Canyon Enterprises, LLC (LLC) and C5 Youth Foundation of Southern California, Inc. (C5), as owners and/or operators of the Camp Paintrock Water System (System), to comply with the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. Section 300f <u>et seq.</u>, and its implementing regulations, the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations, 40 C.F.R. part 141.

Our records indicate that LLC and C5 are in violation of the Order. Among other things, the Order included the following requirement (from item 10 on page 2 of the Order) in which the LLC and C5 are named as Respondents:

Respondents shall comply with the total coliform maximum contaminant level (MCL). If the System's water does not comply with the total coliform MCL in 40 C.F.R. § 141.63, Respondents shall report this violation to the EPA by the end of the business day after discovering the violation, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.21(g)(1).

Monitoring results from the System exceeded the total coliform MCL in August 2015.

The EPA is considering additional enforcement action as a result of the LLC and C5's non-compliance with the Order. Violating an Administrative Order may lead to (1) a penalty of up to \$37,500 per day per violation of the Order, and/or (2) a court injunction ordering compliance.
