## **Consent Agreement and Final Order**

## **Preliminary Statement**

Complainant, the Director of the Land and Chemicals Division, United States
 Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA), Region 5, brought these administrative actions

seeking civil penalties under Section 3008(a) of the Solid Waste Disposal Act, as amended, also known as the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), 42 U.S.C. § 6928(a).

- 2. On August 4, 2009, U.S. EPA filed two separate Complaints against Respondents Creative Liquid Coatings, Inc., formerly known as Creative Coatings, Inc., Elite Enterprises, Inc., and Randall Geist. The Complaints allege that the Respondents violated provisions of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. § 6901, et seq. and related state and federal regulations, at Suites 1284 and 1158 at 2701 S. Coliseum Boulevard, Fort Wayne, Indiana. The Complaints allege that the Respondents stored hazardous waste without a permit or interim status at both locations and failed to comply with the manifest requirements at both locations. The violations were identified as a result of a June 22, 2005, inspection by U.S. EPA. The Complainant moved to consolidate the two Complaints into one matter on March 12, 2010, and the motion was granted on April 15, 2010.
- 3. Respondents Geist and Creative Liquid Coatings, Inc. filed Answers on September 25, 2009, and requested a hearing under Section 3008(b) of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. § 6928(b), and 40 C.F.R. § 22.15.

#### **Stipulations**

- 4. Unless otherwise specified, Settling Respondents refers to Randall Geist, individually and as a shareholder in the other two Respondents, Elite Enterprises, Inc. and Creative Liquid Coatings, Inc. as signatories to this agreement.
- 5. Settling Respondents admit the jurisdictional allegations in the Complaints and neither admit nor deny the factual allegations in the Complaints other than those admitted in their Answers.
  - 6. Settling Respondents waive any right to contest the allegations in the Complaint and

their right to appeal this Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO).

- 7. Settling Respondents certify that, to their knowledge, they are complying fully with applicable portions of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 6901 6992k, and the regulations at 40 C.F.R. §§ 260.1 279.82 at the location(s) identified in the Complaints.
- 8. Settling Respondents consent to the assessment of the civil penalty specified in this CAFO and to the terms of this CAFO.
- 9. The parties agree that settling this action without further litigation, upon the terms of this CAFO, is in the public interest.

### **Civil Penalty**

10. The Parties agree that Settling Respondents will pay \$70,000 in settlement of the allegations and proposed penalty in the Complaints. Settling Respondents are jointly and severally responsible for payment of the agreed upon amount. Settling Respondents have requested and Complainant agrees that Settling Respondents will pay the \$70,000 civil penalty with interest of \$906.16 in four equal installments of \$17,726.54. The first installment is due within 30 days of the date of filing of this CAFO. The remaining three installments are due within 120, 240 and 360 days of filing of this CAFO. Settling Respondents may pre-pay without incurring a penalty. Settling Respondents must contact Blake Edwards, Financial Specialist, U.S. EPA, HQ at 513-487-2096 for written instructions and the appropriate amount due for any pre-payment. Settling Respondents may pay the installments in any of the following methods provided they comply with the correct payment method instructions provided herein — if cashier's checks, then payable to "Treasurer, United States of America," to:

- 12. This civil penalty is not deductible for federal tax purposes.
- 13. If Settling Respondents do not pay an installment payment as set forth in paragraph 10 above, the entire unpaid balance of the civil penalties, and any amount required by paragraph 14 below, shall become due and owing upon written notice by U.S. EPA to Settling Respondents of the delinquency. U.S. EPA may bring an action to collect any unpaid portion of the penalty with interest, handling charges, nonpayment penalties, and the United States' enforcement expenses for the collection action. The validity, amount, and appropriateness of the civil penalty are not reviewable in a collection action.
  - 14. Pursuant to 31 C.F.R. § 901.9, Settling Respondents must pay the following on any

amount overdue under this CAFO. Interest will accrue on any overdue amount from the date payment was due at a rate established by the Secretary of the Treasury pursuant to 31 U.S.C. § 3717(a)(1). Settling Respondents must pay a \$15 handling charge each month that any portion of the penalty is more than 30 days past due. In addition, Settling Respondents must pay a 6 percent per year penalty on any principal amount 90 days past due.

## General Provisions

- 15. This CAFO resolves federal civil liability for the violations alleged in the Complaints.
- 16. This CAFO does not affect the right of U.S. EPA or the United States to pursue appropriate criminal sanctions for the violations alleged in the Complaints.
- 17. This CAFO does not affect Settling Respondents' responsibility to comply with RCRA and other applicable federal, state, local laws and permits.
- 18. This CAFO is a "final order" for purposes of 40 C.F.R. § 22.31, U.S. EPA's RCRA Civil Penalty Policy, and U.S. EPA's Hazardous Waste Civil Enforcement Response Policy (December 2003).
- 19. The terms of this CAFO bind the U.S. EPA and the Settling Respondents, their successors, and assigns.
- 20. Each person signing this agreement certifies that he or she has the authority to sign for the party whom he or she represents and to bind that party to its terms.
  - 21. Each party agrees to bear its own costs and attorney's fees in this action.
  - 22. This CAFO constitutes the entire agreement between the parties.
