Enclosed please find an executed copy of the Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) that resolves the Clean Air Act (CAA) matter (Docket No. CAA-04-2010-8013(b)) involving The Pictsweet Company. EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

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DOCKET NO: <u>CAA-04-2010-8013(b)</u>

This ESA is issued to:

The Pictsweet Company 2170 Anderson Avenue Brownsville, TN 38012

for violating 40 CFR § 68.15, 40 CFR § 68.67, 40 CFR § 68.69, 40 CFR § 68.71 and Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act.

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 4, the Director of the Air, Pesticides and Toxics Management Division (Complainant), and by The Pictsweet Company (Respondent), pursuant to Section 113(a)(3) and (d) of the Clean Air Act (the "Act"), 42 U.S.C. § 7413(a)(3) and (d), and pursuant to 40 CFR § 22.13(b).

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

Based on a compliance monitoring inspection conducted at the Respondent's facility located at 2170 Anderson Avenue, Brownsville, Tennessee, on October 16, 2008, EPA alleges that the Respondent violated the Act's Chemical Accident Prevention Program when Respondent did not provide evidence that:

It has developed a management system to oversee the implementation of the risk management program, documented persons responsible for implementing individual requirements, and defined lines of authority through an organization chart or similar document as required by 40 C. F. R. § 68.15(a) & (c);

It developed a written schedule for the implementation/completion of recommendations (action items) resulting from the 2004 process hazard analysis, and document the outcome and completion of action items as required by 40 CFR § 68.67(e);

It has certified annually that its operating procedures are current and accurate and that procedures have been reviewed as often as necessary as required by 40 CFR § 68.69(c); and

It has ascertained and documented in a record that each employee involved in operating a process has received and understood the training as required by 40 C.F.R § 68.71(c).

SETTLEMENT

In consideration of Respondent's size, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violation cited above, for the total penalty amount of **\$2040**.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions: the Respondent by signing below admits the jurisdictional allegations contained herein, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above; Respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C § 7413(d)(2)(A), and to contest the allegations contained in this ESA; and each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.

Respondent certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that the Respondent has corrected the alleged violation listed in this ESA. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of **\$2040.** Please note that payment <u>should not</u> be made until after Respondent receives a copy of the <u>fully executed</u> ESA. Within fifteen (15) days of receiving a copy of the fully executed ESA, the Respondent shall send a cashier's check or certified check (payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America") in the amount of **\$2040,** in payment of the full penalty amount to one of the following addresses:
