Dear President Azure and Ms. Nicholson:

On April 7, 2011, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Emergency Administrative Order (Order), under section 1431 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (the Act), 40 U.S.C. § 300i, to the Fort Belknap Indian Community (FBIC) and Prairie Mountain Utilities (the Utility), as owner and/or operator of the Agnes Leggins Public Water System (the system). The Order was issued following a water main break which caused a loss of water pressure for an extended period of time. It recently came to our attention that this Order may not have been formally closed.
