Dear Mr. Livingston:

On November 1, 2013, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (the EPA) issued Field #4, LLC and Constructors West, Inc. (Respondents) the Administrative Order for Compliance on Consent referenced above (the Order). In the Order, the EPA made findings that the Respondents had discharged pollutants from a construction site (the Site) in Grand Junction, Colorado, without a permit, in violation of the Clean Water Act.

The Order required the Respondents, among other things, to apply for coverage for discharges from the Site under a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit, to submit a Stormwater Management Plan (SWMP) and a site map to the EPA, to document corrective actions taken in response to the EPA's compliance inspection conducted at the Site on July 17, 2012, and to submit quarterly reports to the EPA for the life of the construction project at the Site or until receiving notification from the EPA that quarterly reports were no longer required.

The EPA has recently reviewed the submission history for the Site. The Respondents have obtained permit coverage for discharges from the Site (Colorado Discharge Permit System No. COR03L567), submitted their SWMP and site map to the EPA, documented corrective action, and submitted quarterly reports to the EPA. Most construction at the Site has been completed.

Therefore, by this letter, the EPA is providing notice pursuant to section 36.iv of the Order that quarterly submissions are no longer required. Because the only remaining requirement of the Order is to submit an Inactivation Notice pursuant to section 36.vii of the Order, and because this is also a requirement of Permit No. COR03L567, which remains in effect, the EPA is hereby closing the Order.

The Respondents will remain obligated to comply with the Clean Water Act, all its implementing regulations, and Permit No. COR03L567. The EPA is not precluded from initiating an enforcement action for any future violations of these requirements.
