I am pleased to inform you that on May 20, 2009, the notice of the "Settlement Agreement for Recovery of Past Costs" (Settlement Agreement) for the Bueno Mill and Mine Site in Jamestown, Boulder County, Colorado was published in the *Federal Register*. As you are aware, the proposed settlement was subject to a thirty-day public comment period, which ran through June 19, 2009. Enclosed please find a complete copy of the final, fully-executed Settlement Agreement.

In accordance with Section XIV. of the Settlement Agreement (Public Comment), EPA hereby notifies you that the public comment period has ended and that EPA has received no comments that would require modification of, or withdrawal from, the Settlement Agreement. Pursuant to Section XV. of the Settlement Agreement (Effective Date), the Settlement Agreement becomes effective as of the date of this letter.

In accordance with Section V of the Settlement Agreement (Payment of Response Costs), Ozark-Mahoning Company and its parents, Delaware Chemicals Corporation and Arkema Inc.'s payment of One Million Three Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Six Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$1,321,619) is due within thirty (30) days of the effective date of the Order (the date of this letter). Payment is to be made as set forth in Section V (Payment of Response Costs).
