Attached is a RCRA Expedited Settlement Agreement (“ESA”) that has been signed by all parties and is now being submitted to you for approval in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 22.18(b). Please note that, consistent with 40 C.F.R. §§ 22.13(b) and 22.18(b), this ESA both commences and concludes the matter referenced above.

The 2021 RCRA Expedited Settlement Agreement Pilot (“2021 RCRA ESA Pilot” or “Pilot”) pursuant to the November 24, 2014, memorandum titled “Revised Guidance on the Use of Expedited Settlement Agreements” (2014 ESA Guidance) and corresponding model documents approves the use of ESAs for certain easily correctable violations. Under the terms of the proposed Agreement, Respondent will pay a civil penalty of \$11,250. There is no public notice requirement for this settlement.
