Dear Mike Domine:

On March 10, 2025, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency issued a Notice of Violation and a Compliance Order/Settlement Agreement (Settlement Agreement) for violations of the Federal underground storage tank (UST) regulations at the City of Northville facility located at 650 Doheny Drive, Northville, Michigan. The violations were identified during an EPA UST inspection conducted on December 3, 2024.

On March 13, 2025, EPA received your supporting documentation that the violations have been corrected. On April 3, 2025, EPA received your signed copy of the Settlement Agreement. Your payment of \$1,630 was confirmed by our finance office on April 3, 2025. The Settlement Agreement states that it is effective upon EPA's final approval. I have enclosed a signed and dated copy of the approved Settlement Agreement. The original Settlement Agreement will remain in EPA's file. We also have accepted and processed your payment as part of the settlement process.
