On June 4, 2025, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency issued a Notice of Violation and a Compliance Order/Settlement Agreement (Settlement Agreement) for violations of the Federal underground storage tank (UST) regulations at Pontiac Fuel Corp – Sunoco Station facility located at 45054 Woodward Avenue, Pontiac, Michigan. The violations were identified during an EPA UST inspection conducted on April 10, 2025.

On June 6, 2025, EPA received your signed copy of the Settlement Agreement. On April 10, 2025, Pontiac Fuel Corp – Sunoco Station corrected the violation. Your payment of \$645 was confirmed on June 6, 2025. The Settlement Agreement states that it is effective upon EPA's final approval. I have enclosed a signed and dated copy of the approved Settlement Agreement. The original Settlement Agreement will remain in EPA's file. We also have accepted and processed your payment as part of the settlement process.
