Dear Mr. Byrne:

On January 13, 2026, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency issued a Notice of Violation and a Compliance Order/Settlement Agreement (Settlement Agreement) for violations of the Federal underground storage tank (UST) regulations at the Speedway #8792 facility located at 6825 South Cedar Street, Lansing, Michigan. The violations were identified during an EPA UST inspection conducted on December 9, 2025.

On February 4, 2026, EPA received your signed copy of the Settlement Agreement. On January 26, 2026, EPA received your supporting documentation that the violation has been corrected. Your payment of \$645 was confirmed by our finance office on February 9, 2026. The Settlement Agreement states that it is effective upon EPA's final approval. I have enclosed a signed and dated copy of the approved Settlement Agreement. The original Settlement Agreement will remain in EPA's file. We also have accepted and processed your payment as part of the settlement process.
