This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Administrative Order (Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2009-0059, issued to the Turnerville Water and Sewer District (the District) on July 9, 2009. EPA has determined that the District has complied with the requirements of the Administrative Order and therefore we will close the Order at this time. Please note: EPA has determined that the system properly sampled and submitted results for total coliform bacteria during the month of October 2010; therefore the violation letter EPA issued on December 13, 2010, should be disregarded.

Please be aware that the Turnerville Water and Sewer District is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (NPDWRs), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
