Under Section 3008(a) of the Solid Waste Disposal Act, also known as the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976, as amended by the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984, 42 U.S.C. § 6928(a), the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 5 (U.S. EPA) filed a fully-executed Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO) with the Regional Hearing Clerk on September 19, 2007, in resolution of the above-referenced case involving the AlSCO Inc. (AlSCO) facility in Chicago, Illinois.


Paragraph 67 of the CAFO states that the CAFO terminates when U.S. EPA determines that AlSCO has fully complied with all terms and conditions of the CAFO, including full payment of all penalties due and owing, and U.S. EPA provides written notice to AlSCO of such termination.

U.S. EPA hereby acknowledges that AlSCO has paid the entire penalty amount of \$280,587.00, which was received by the Treasurer on October 1, 2007, and that AlSCO provided U.S. EPA program staff notice of the payment on October 2, 2007, pursuant to Paragraphs 50 through 52 of the CAFO.

Therefore, pursuant to Paragraph 67 of the CAFO, U.S. EPA is hereby providing AlSCO with written notice that the CAFO has been terminated.
