#### **LEGAL AUTHORITY**

1. This Consent Agreement is proposed and entered into under the authority vested in the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") by Section 311(b)(6)(B)(i) of the Clean Water Act, as amended, ("Act"), 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(6)(B)(i), and under the authority provided by 40 CFR §§ 22.13(b) and 22.18(b)(2). The Administrator has delegated these authorities to the Regional Administrator of EPA, Region III, who has in turn delegated them to the Director of the Region's Hazardous Site Cleanup Division ("Complainant").

#### **CONSENT AGREEMENT**

#### **Stipulations**

The parties, in their own capacity or by their attorneys or other authorized representatives, hereby stipulate and admit:

2. Respondent is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of Pennsylvania with a principal place of business located at 301 Brush Creek Road, Warrendale PA 15086, and a mailing address of Post Office Box 5519, Vienna, West Virginia 26105-5519.

The Respondent is a person within the meaning of Section 311(a)(7) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1321(a)(7), and 40 CFR §112.2.

- 3. Respondent is the owner and operator of the Dorsey Baker Heirs Well and associated crude oil gathering line(s) ("the Facility"), which is an onshore facility within the meaning of Section 311(a)(10) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1321(a)(10), and 40 CFR §112.2. The Facility is located at or around Laugherty Fork near Shirley, Doddrigde County, West Virginia.
- 4. Laugherty Fork is a tributary of Elklick Run, which is a tributary to McElroy Creek, which is a tributary to Middle Island Creek, which is a tributary to the Ohio River, a navigable water of the United States as defined in Section 502(7) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1362(7), and 40 CFR §110.1.
- 5. Section 311(b)(3) of the Act prohibits the discharge of oil or a hazardous substance into or upon the navigable waters of the United States or adjoining shorelines in such quantities that have been determined may be harmful to the public health or welfare or environment of the United States.
- 6. For purposes of Section 311(b)(3) and (b)(4) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1321(b)(3) and (b)(4), discharges of oil into or upon the navigable waters of the United States in such quantities that have been determined may be harmful to the public health or welfare or environment of the United States are defined in 40 CFR §110.3 to include discharges of oil that violate applicable water quality standards or cause a film or a sheen upon or discoloration of the surface of the water or adjoining shorelines or eause a sludge or emulsion to be deposited beneath the surface of the water or upon the adjoining shorelines.

- 8. Approximately three (3) barrels of the discharged oil entered the waters of Laugherty Fork, a tributary to Elklick Run, a tributary to McElroy Creek, a tributary to Middle Island Creek, a tributary to the Ohio River, which is a navigable water of the United States as defined in Section 502(7) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1362(7), and 40 C.F.R. §110.1.
- 9. Respondent's discharge of crude oil on or about March 31, 2010, from the Facility caused a sheen upon or discoloration of the surface of Laugherty Fork, and, therefore, was in a quantity that has been determined may be harmful under 40 C.F.R §110.3, which implements Section 311(b)(3) and (b)(4) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1321(b)(3) and (b)(4).
- 10. Respondent's discharge of oil from its Facility into or upon Laugherty Fork in a quantity that has been determined may be harmful under 40 C.F.R. §110.3, on or about March31, violated Section 311(b)(3) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. §1321(b)(3).

### Waiver of Rights

11. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of EPA in this matter and waives its right to a hearing under Section 311(b)(6)(B)(i) of the Act and to appeal any Final Order in this matter under Section 311(b)(6)(G)(i) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1321(b)(6)(G)(i), and consents to the issuance of a Final Order without further adjudication.

#### Penalty

12. The Complainant proposes, and Respondent consents to, the assessment of a civil penalty of \$4,500.00.

### Payment Terms

Based on the foregoing, the parties, in their own capacity or by their attorneys or authorized representatives, hereby agree that:

#### **General Provisions**

- 16. The Final Order shall be binding upon Respondent and Respondent's officers, directors, agents, servants, employees, and successors or assigns.
- 17. The Final Order does not constitute a waiver, suspension or modification of the requirements of Section 311 of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1321, or any regulations promulgated thereunder, and does not affect the right of the Administrator or the United States to pursue any applicable injunctive or other equitable relief or criminal sanctions for any violation of law.

  Payment of the penalty pursuant to this Consent Agreement resolves only Respondent's liability for federal civil penalties for the violations of the Act and facts stipulated to herein.
- 18. The provisions of the Final Order shall be binding upon Respondent, and its successors or assigns. The undersigned officer of Respondent represents and warrants that he or she has the authority to bind East Resources, Inc., and its successors or assigns.
