Preliminary Statement

1. Complainant, the Director of the Land and Chemicals Division, United States

Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 5, brought this administrative action seeking a

civil penalty under Section 16(a) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), 15 U.S.C.

§ 2615(a).

REGIONAL HEARING CLERK

USEPA

- 2. On February 9, 2009, EPA filed the Complaint in this action against Respondent Kathryn Y. Lewis-Campbell. The Complaint alleges that Respondent violated Section 1018(b)(5) of the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992, 42 U.S.C. § 4852d(b)(5); Section 409 of TSCA, 15 U.S.C. § 2689; and 40 C.F.R. §§ 745.107(a)(1) and 745.113(a)(1) (5), in a contract to sell target housing.
- 3. On March 18, 2009, Respondent filed an Answer denying the allegations and requested a hearing in this matter.

Stipulations

- 4. Respondent admits the jurisdictional allegations in the Complaint and neither admits nor denies the factual allegations in the Complaint.
- 5. Respondent waives any right to further contest the allegations in the Complaint and her right to appeal this Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO).

- 6. Respondent certifies that she is complying fully with the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 and the regulations at 40 C.F.R. Part 745.
- 7. Respondent consents to the assessment of the civil penalty stated in this CAFO and to the terms of this CAFO.
- 8. The parties agree that settling this action without further litigation, upon the terms of this CAFO, is in the public interest.

Civil Penalties

9. In consideration of Respondent's inability to pay a penalty, EPA agrees to mitigate the proposed penalty of \$43,238 to \$0.

General Provisions

- 10. This CAFO resolves Respondent's liability for federal civil penalties for the violations alleged in the Complaint, which is the only matter addressed by this Complaint.
- 11. This CAFO does not affect the right of EPA or the United States to pursue appropriate injunctive or other equitable relief or criminal sanctions for any violation of law by the Respondent.
- 12. This CAFO does not affect Respondent's responsibility to comply with the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 and other applicable federal, state, and local laws.
 - 13. The terms of this CAFO bind Respondent, and her successors and assigns.
- 14. Each person signing this agreement certifies that he or she has the authority to sign for the party whom he or she represents and to bind that party to its terms.
 - 15. Each party agrees to bear its own costs and attorney's fees in this action.

16. This CAFO constitutes and entire agreement between the parties.
