EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT (ESA)

This complaint is issued to: Lyondell Chemical Co. - Channelview Operations (South Plant)

At: 2502 Sheldon Road, Channelview, TX 77530 For: Violating Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 6, by its duly delegated official, the Director, Enforcement and Compliance Assurance Division, and by Lyondell Chemical Co. - Channelview Operations South Plant (Respondent) pursuant to Section I13(a)(3) and (d) of the Clean Air Act (the Act), 42 U.S.C. § 74 I3(a)(3) and (d), and by 40 C.F.R. § 22.13(b). EPA and the United States Department of Justice have jointly determined that EPA may pursue this type of case as an administrative penalty action under Section 113(d)(1) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(d)(1).

From June 5-7, 2018, an authorized representative of the EPA conducted a compliance inspection of the subject facility (Respondent) to determine compliance with the Risk Management Plan (RMP) regulations promulgated at 40 C.F.R. Part 68 under Section I 12(r) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7412(r). EPA found that the Respondent had violated regulations implementing Section 112(r) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7412(r), by failing to comply with the regulations as noted below:

1) 40 C.F.R. § 68.67(t) - "At least every five (5) years after the completion of the initial process hazard analysis (PHA), the PHA shall be updated and revalidated by a team meeting the requirements in paragraph (d) of this section, to assure that the PHA is consistent with the current process. Updated and revalidated PHAs completed to comply with 29 CFR 1910.119(e) are acceptable to meet the requirements of this paragraph."

Respondent's PHA for the POSM I 100/200 Area was not revalidated at least every five years. This was I of 29 PHA's conducted at the facility. This is a violation of the five-year requirement in 40 C.F.R. § 68.67(t).

SETTLEMENT

In consideration of the factors set forth in Section 113(e) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(e), including Respondent's size of business, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violations, described above for the total penalty amount of \$2,500. This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions:

The Respondent by signing below waives any objections that it may have regarding jurisdiction, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above. Respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(d)(2)(A), and to appeal this ESA. Each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any. Respondent also certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that the Respondent has corrected the violations listed above, or has entered into an enforceable Administrative Order to correct the violations identified above, and has sent a cashier's check or certified check (payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America") in the amount of \$2,500 in payment of the full penalty amount to the following address:

Respondent's full payment of the penalty as provided in this Settlement Agreement shall resolve Respondent's liability for Federal civil penalties for the violations and facts alleged above. EPA does not waive any enforcement action by EPA for any other past, present, or future violations under the Act or any other statute.

If the <u>Settlement Agreement wilh an attached copy of the certified check</u> is not returned to the <u>EPA</u> <u>Region 6 office</u> at the above address in correct form by the Respondent within 30 days of the date of the receipt of this Settlement Agreement, the Complaint and ESA is withdrawn, without prejudice to EPA's ability to file additional enforcement actions for the violations identified in this Settlement Agreement.

Respondent has the right to request a hearing on any material fact or on the appropriateness of the penalty contained in this complaint pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.14. Upon signing and returning of this Settlement Agreement to EPA, the Respondent waives the opportunity for a hearing pursuant to Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(d)(2)(A).

This Settlement Agreement is binding on the EPA and the Respondent. By signing below, the Respondent waives any objections to EPA's jurisdiction with respect to the Settlement Agreement and consents to

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EPA's approval of this Settlement Agreement without further notice. This Settlement Agreement is effective upon filing with the Regional Hearing Clerk.
