On October 28, 2009, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, RCRA Programs Section issued a Notice of Violation and a Compliance Order/Settlement Agreement concerning underground storage tank (UST) violation (i.e., release detection), found at the Sunset Marina facility, 13623 South Hoxie, Chicago, Illinois. This letter is to inform you that we have received your signed copy of the Settlement Agreement, dated November 13, 2009, and your supporting documentation stating that the UST violation was addressed. In addition, we received your check (#5929) for a total of \$150.00 in penalties. In addition, we were informed that you sent a second check (#5930) in error to our Cincinnati Finance Center. We were later informed, on 11/23/09 by that office (and on 12/9/09 by you), that you have been reimbursed for this second check.

This is to inform you that I have enclosed a signed and dated copy of the approved Settlement Agreement. The original Settlement Agreement will remain in the EPA's files.
