Dear Counsel:

I have been designated as the Presiding Officer in the referenced proceeding, involving the proposed assessment of a civil penalty under Section 1447(b) of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. § 300j-6(b). The proceeding is governed by EPA's Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties, Issuance of Compliance or Corrective Action Orders, and the Revocation, Termination or Suspension of Permits, 40 C.F.R. Part 22, published at 64 Fed. Reg. 40137 (July 23, 1999).

## PREHEARING CONFERENCE:

Section 22.19(b) of the Consolidated Rules allows the Presiding Officer to hold a prehearing conference among all the parties to consider: (1) Settlement of the case; (2) Simplification of issues and stipulation of facts not in dispute; (3) The necessity or desirability of amending the pleadings; (4) The exchange of exhibits, documents, prepared testimony, and admissions or stipulations of fact which will avoid unnecessary proof; (5) The limitation of the number of expert or other witnesses; (6) The time and place for the hearing; and (7) Any other matters which may expedite the disposition of the proceeding. The conference may be held by telephone. 40 C.F.R. § 22.19(d).

Accordingly, I will hold the **prehearing conference by telephone on Tuesday, December 18, 2012, beginning at 9:00 AM,** or as soon thereafter as I can make the necessary arrangements. Unless you advise me otherwise, I will call Ms. Fischer at (212) 637-3223 and Mr. Conte at (617) 527-3400. Please be prepared to discuss the matters enumerated in the preceding paragraph.
