
Dear Ms. Johnson:

This 5th Addendum to the Administrative Order, Docket No. SDWS-08-2009-0019, issued July 2, 2009 to the Carter Chouteau County Water and Sewer District (Respondent or the District), is in response to the September 18, 2012 email, from Keith Lippert on behalf of the District, requesting a deadline extension for the date to begin construction. The request is for extending the deadline from September 30, 2012 to January 1, 2013 for construction start time. The request for extension is due to a delay in equipment delivery for the project. The contractor is required to complete construction within 40 days of starting and therefore cannot begin construction prior to receiving all equipment. This extension will not change the overall project completion date of March 31, 2013.

This letter constitutes the written approval by EPA for extending the deadlines as shown in the schedule below. This letter serves to incorporate the following revised schedule into the Administrative Order, meaning each deadline in the schedule will be an enforceable part of the Administrative Order.

Please note that EPA expects this approved schedule to be met. If unexpected events occur that are beyond Respondent's control and that will require Respondent to request an extension of these deadlines, Respondent is responsible for notifying EPA well in advance of the deadline dates. EPA will not consider extending these deadlines without a clear justification for their need. Respondent must provide the following information in any request for extensions: a description of the work that has been completed and the additional work that will not be completed by the deadline dates, the unexpected events that occurred, how Respondent attempted to foresee or overcome these obstacles and an explanation that justifies the new proposed deadline dates.
