
Dear Ms. Hamilton and Mr. Seeton:

This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Administrative Order (Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2007-0040, issued on March 23, 2007 to the USDA Forest Service and Mr. Todd Seeton, owner and operator respectively of the Bridger-Teton National Forest - Granite Creek Campground public water system. The EPA has determined that the USDA Forest Service and Mr. Seeton have complied with the requirements of the Administrative Order and therefore we will close the Order at this time.

Please be aware that the USDA Forest Service and Mr. Seeton are still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations or an administrative order may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
