This letter is to inform you and the Carter Chouteau County Water and Sewer District, of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) decision to close Administrative Order, Docket No. SDWA-08-2009-0019 (Order), issued to Carter Chouteau County Water and Sewer District, owner and/or operator of the Carter Chouteau County Water and Sewer District public water system, on July 2, 2009. The EPA has determined that this system is now in compliance with the terms of the Order and, therefore, we will close the Order at this time.

Please be aware that the Carter Chouteau County Water and Sewer District is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations at 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of these regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
