MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO RESPOND TO ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT, COMPLIANCE ORDER, AND NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING WITH CONSENT OF EPA ENFORCEMENT COUNSEL

NOW COMES THE STATE OF MAINE HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL TESTING LABORATORY ("HETL"), Respondent, by and through its attorney, Deanna L. White, Assistant Attorney General, and requests an extension of the deadline for Respondent to file an Answer to the Complaint, seek administrative review of the Compliance Order, and Request a Hearing to May 27, 2015, and in support thereof states as follows:
