- 4. Enerco in an effort to further negotiations provided information to the Complainant which shows that approximately two percent (2%) of the fluids contained in the pipeline that ruptured is Basic Sediment and Water ("BS&W").
- Enerco continues to offer to the Complainant the opportunity to meet at the location of the alleged violation.
- Enerco believes it is possible for the Parties to reach a settlement and agrees with the
 Complainant that 45 days is sufficient time to make that determination.
