Complainant, United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 8 (EPA), and Respondent Town of Springfield (Respondent), by their undersigned representatives, hereby consent and agree as follows.

#### BACKGROUND

- On February 29, 2008, EPA issued a Proposed Compliance Order, Penalty Complaint and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing (Complaint) to Respondent for certain violations of Part C of the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), 42 U.S.C. § 300h et seq., and the underground injection control (UIC) regulations promulgated thereunder.
- Respondent admits the jurisdictional allegations of the Complaint and neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations of the Complaint.
- Respondent waives its rights to a hearing before any tribunal and to contest any issue of law or fact set forth in the Complaint or this Consent Agreement.
- 4. This Consent Agreement, upon incorporation into a final order, applies to and is binding

- upon EPA and upon Respondent and Respondent's successors or assigns. This Consent Agreement contains all terms of the settlement agreed to by the parties.
- 5. EPA acknowledges that Respondent has timely closed the Class V injection well at issue and removed and disposed of associated concrete, piping and contaminated soil excavated from the site and has submitted documentary evidence of the closure, removal and disposal to EPA.
- 6. Respondent agrees to keep the Class V injection well at issue permanently closed.
- 7. Due to Respondent's timely compliance and in consideration of the statutory penalty factors in 42 U.S.C. § 300h-2(c)(4)(B), EPA agrees to settle this action without the assessment of a civil penalty.
- Nothing in this Consent Agreement shall relieve Respondent of the duty to comply with the SDWA and its implementing regulations.
- 9. The undersigned representative of Respondent certifies that he is fully authorized to enter into the terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement and to bind Respondent to the terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement.
- 10. The parties agree to submit this Consent Agreement to the Regional Judicial Officer, with a request that it be incorporated into a final order.
- 11. Each party shall bear its own costs and attorneys fees in connection with this matter.

12. This Consent Agreement, upon incorporation into a final order by the Regional Judicial Officer and full satisfaction by the parties, shall be a complete and full civil settlement of the specific violations alleged in the Complaint.
