Dear Mr. Field:

This Addendum to the Administrative Order (Order) issued January 5, 2012, to the Woodenshoe Pipeline Company (Woodenshoe) constitutes the written approval by the EPA of the compliance schedule extension request submitted by Attorney Steven E. Clyde on behalf of Woodenshoe on July 10, 2013. It is necessary to extend the project completion date to May 30, 2014, because of delays in completing negotiations with the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District (WBWCD) and the necessity of obtaining an exception on minimum pressure requirements from the Utah Department of Environmental Quality. The new schedule for implementing and completing system improvements is shown below, and is incorporated into the Order per paragraph 20 of the Order.

* In the event the Water Right Exchange Application is protested, the State Engineer's approval may be delayed, which would affect the timetable of the subsequent items.

Please note that EPA expects this approved schedule to be met. While not creating any right to an extension, EPA in its discretion may consider granting an extension to compliance order deadlines under limited circumstances. If unexpected events occur that are beyond Woodenshoe's control and that may require Woodenshoe to request an extension of these deadlines, Woodenshoe is responsible for notifying EPA well in advance of the deadline dates. EPA will not consider extending these deadlines without a clear justification for their need. Woodenshoe must provide the following information in writing for any request for extensions: a description of the work that has been completed and the additional work that may not be completed by the deadline dates; the unexpected events that have occurred or may occur and how Woodenshoe has attempted to foresee and use its best efforts to overcome these obstacles; and proposed new deadline dates with justification for the length of the proposed new deadlines.

As a reminder, Woodenshoe is required to submit quarterly progress reports to EPA and UTDEQ within 10 days of the end of each calendar quarter per paragraph 21 of the Order.

Please be advised that Woodenshoe is required to comply with all provisions of the Order. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.
