Dear Mr. Robbins:

In a letter dated April 7, 2010, you requested an extension of time to comply with the Class V well closure requirements contained in the Proposed Compliance Order, Penalty Complaint, and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, sent to the Peyton School District on March 17, 2010. With this letter, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) acknowledges receipt of your request.

Your request for an extension is granted, making the deadline for submittal of the schedule for permanent closure of the disposal well and plan for alternative waste disposal May 21, 2010. Please note that if the closure includes the use of a self-contained holding tank, the plan must address the specific type, specifications and size of tank to be installed.

This extension also includes the deadline for permanently closing the well, which will now be June 21, 2010.

Within 30 days calendar days of completing the well closure, you must provide EPA documentation of the closure. In the documentation, please include the date of closure; a written description of the closure; receipts from any contractors involved in the well closure; photos documenting the closure; and any other appropriate documentation.

Send the schedule for well closure and alternative waste disposal plan, as well as subsequent documentation of closure to:

Failure to meet the deadlines set forth in this letter may jeopardize your opportunity to settle this case without the assessment of a civil penalty.
