On November 28, 2011, Lafarge submitted an unopposed motion for extension of ninety (90) days to respond to the Administrative Complaint. On November 30, 2011, the Regional Judicial Hearing entered an order granting Lafarge until February 27, 2012 to respond.

The parties are still in active good-faith negotiations and have made substantial progress toward a resolution of the case.
