The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 3, ("EPA") issued the above-referenced Administrative Order to Stallion Run Estates ("the System") on August 5, 2025. In response to that Administrative Order, the System submitted the following as required by 40 C.F.R. §§ 141.84(a), 141.90(e), and 40 C.F.R. §141.85(e): their service line inventory; a copy of the notification letter that was sent to customers and all persons served by the water system at the service connection of a service line that is known to contain, or may potentially contain, lead; and certification that their service line inventory is accessible to the public. Pursuant to Section VI "Termination" of the Administrative Order, the EPA is informing you that the System completed the requirements of the Order, and the EPA is terminating the Order as of the date of this letter.

Please be advised that System continues to be subject to the SDWA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 300f - 300j-27, and the applicable requirements of the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations found in 40 C.F.R. Part 141.
