Dear Mr. Goodrum:

On October 13, 2015, an Administrative Order for Compliance (CWA-07-2015-0103) was issued by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to Goodrum Farm CR314, LLC, under the authority of Section 309(a) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1319(a). The EPA has reviewed the information submitted in response to the reporting requirements in the Order and the current conditions of the site. This letter serves as a notification to you that the EPA is terminating the referenced Order. The EPA's decision to terminate the Order is conditioned upon the accuracy of the representations made to the EPA in response to the requirements of the Order.

Termination of the Order in no way relieves you of the obligation to comply with the CWA and all applicable statutes and regulations along with all covenants and restrictions or conservation easements established for the site. The effect of this termination is limited to the reporting requirements imposed under the Order. The EPA reserves all of its authorities, both legal and equitable, under the CWA and any other statutory, regulatory, or common law authorities of the United States.
