ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

A Order Scheduling Hearing was issued on April 18, 2012 in this matter ordering the parties to file a Joint Set of Stipulated Facts, Exhibits and Testimony by July 20, 2012. On July 20, 2012, Complainant filed a Motion, requesting Extension of Time to File Joint Set of Stipulated Facts, Exhibits and Testimony seeking a final extension of fifteen (15) days. Grounds stated in the motion are Complainant was out of the office for several weeks for medical reasons and had previous commitments and Counsel for Respondent has also been out of the office. Complainant notes that Respondent does not oppose the Motion.

The Rules of Practice that govern this proceeding, 40 C.F.R. Part 22, provide that the presiding officer may grant an extension of time for filing any document "upon timely motion . . . , for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties." 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b).

The unopposed Motion is hereby GRANTED for good cause in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 22.7(b). In the event the parties have not filed a fully executed Consent Agreement and Final Order settling this matter beforehand, the parties shall file Stipulated Facts, Exhibits and Testimony on or before August 6, 2012.


