This letter is to advise you of an administrative complaint which Region 10 of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has filed in the State of Washington. The proposed penalty action is in response to alleged violations of the Clean Water Act (CWA) by Chill Transportation LLC for unauthorized discharges of oil into Toppenish Creek, wetlands adjacent to Toppenish Creek and the shoreline of Toppenish Creek, within the exterior boundaries of the Yakama Indian Reservation, and the Toppenish National Wildlife Refuge.

EPA is providing notice of this action to the State of Washington pursuant to Section 309(g)(1) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. § 1319(g)(1).
