On March 15, 2022, Region 10 of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) sent you a letter notifying you of environmental enforcement of an oil spill within the exterior boundaries of the Yakama Indian Reservation. This letter is to advise you of an administrative complaint which EPA has filed in that matter. The proposed penalty action is in response to alleged violations of the Clean Water Act by Chill Transportation LLC for unauthorized discharges of oil into Toppenish Creek, wetlands adjacent to Toppenish Creek, and the shoreline of Toppenish Creek.
