On October 27, 2011, Respondent filed a Joint Motion to Amend Administrative

Complaint and Consent Agreement. The Motion requests, pursuant to paragraphs D.1.a and F.13

of the Agreement, that the Complaint and Consent Agreement be amended to include a Revised

Appendix A and modification of the penalty.

The Revised Appendix A substitutes the original Appendix A by deleting one source that was incorrectly included, aggregating two sources to constitute one source and aggregating an additional three sources to a constitute one source. This amendment reduces the number of existing emission sources from 93 to 60 and thereby, reduces the penalty to \$273,000 as contemplated by paragraph E.1 of the original Administrative Complaint and Consent Agreement.

The court hereby approves the Motion to Amend to include the Revised Appendix A and the modification to paragraph E.1 based on the terms of the Complaint and Consent Agreement and for good cause shown pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §§22.14(c), 22.16(c) and 22.18(b)(2). The Respondent is hereby **ORDERED** to comply with all of the terms of the Consent Agreement, which was effective on August 29, 2011 by Final Order.

Respondent, Slawson Exploration Company, Inc. ("Slawson"), and Complainant, United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") hereby file this joint motion to amend the Administrative Complaint and Consent Agreement:

- 1. On August 29, 2011, the Court approved an Administrative Complaint and Consent Agreement ("Agreement") in this matter (see August 29, 2011 Order Granting Filing of An Electronic Consent Agreement and Final Order).
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of Paragraphs D.1.a and F.13 of the Agreement, the purpose of this Motion is to request that the Court approve a revised and amended Appendix A to the Agreement ("Revised Appendix A") and approve a revision to Paragraph E.1 of the Agreement to reflect the revised and amended Appendix A.
- 3. Respondent seeks to substitute Revised Appendix A for the original Appendix A to reflect the following changes:
- a. the deletion of an incorrectly included emission source in Table A-1 (Armada Federal 2-14-13II);
- b. aggregation of two emission sources in Table A-1 to constitute a single emission source for 52 (fifty-two) original emission sources, which are now 26 (twentysix) emission sources;
- c. aggregation of three emission sources in Table A-1 to constitute a single emission source for 9 (nine) original emission sources, which are now 3 (three) emission sources;

- d. based on the above changes, revision of the total number of existing emission sources in Table A-1 from 93 to 60.
- 4. To reflect the deletion of the incorrectly included emission source and the aggregation of 61 sources into 29 sources in Table A-1, Respondent seeks to revise Paragraph E.1 of the Agreement to reduce the penalty amount to reflect the net deletion of 33 (thirty-three) emission sources. As proposed, revised Paragraph E.1 would read in its entirety as follows:
- "1. Pursuant to an analysis of the facts and circumstances of this case with the statutory factors described in section 113(d)(l)(B) of the CAA, 43 U.S.C. §7413(d)(l)(B), EPA has determined that an appropriate civil penalty to settle this action is the amount of \$3,000 per emission source listed in Appendix A for a total of Two Hundred Seventy Three Thousand Dollars (\$273,000)."
- 5. Pursuant to the terms of Paragraph F.13 of the Agreement, EPA approves the proposed changes to Paragraph E.1 and Revised Appendix A of the Agreement as set forth in paragraphs 3 and 4 of this Motion.

### REQUEST

For the above-mentioned reasons, Respondent and Complainant respectfully request that the Court approve the revision of Paragraph E.1 and approve substitution of Revised Appendix A into the Agreement.
