


judicial or administrative proceedings, including settlements or orders, under any Environmental Law with respect to which the debtor is or was a party.”

4. Complainant still intends to proceed with a Motion to Withdraw Counts 1, 13, 23 and 33 of the Complaint, and for Default or, in the Alternative, Accelerated Decision on all Remaining Counts of the Complaint.

5. Complainant also intends to request the United States Department of Justice to file a Proof of Claim on behalf of the U.S. EPA in the bankruptcy proceedings.


