Dear Mr. and Ms. Eckdahl:

This letter is the EPA's written approval of the plan outlined in the May 4, 2007, letter from Sue Ann Spencer, Weston Engineering, Inc., to Lisa Kahn, EPA, for bringing the WyColo Lodge public water supply system into compliance with the Maximum Contaminant Level for total coliform. Ms. Spencer's letter was submitted in response to the requirement in Part D.2 of the April 4, 2007, Emergency Administrative Order (AO) referenced above. The AO provides that upon EPA's approval, the plan, including its schedule, will be incorporated into the AO. This letter is therefore an Addendum to the AO.

The following schedule lists the actions that the Respondents named in the AO are to take and the deadlines for completing each action:


<u>Action</u>	<u>Completion Deadline</u>
1) Submit permit to construct to Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (WDEQ)	Complete
2) Drill and complete new well, conduct 24-hour well test, and install pipelines according to construction plans approved by WYDEQ	June 20, 2007
3) Install storage tanks and water treatment according to construction plans approved by WYDEQ	June 26, 2007

| 4) Conduct Cross Connection Survey | July 1, 2007 |
| 5) Plug and abandon existing public water supply well | July 1, 2007 |
| 6) Conduct Microscopic Particulate Analysis (MPA) test | Sept 30, 2007 |


Please be advised that you are required to comply with all provisions of the AO, including the requirements for providing boiled water or an alternative water supply, public notice and monthly progress reports. You must also complete the total coliform testing requirements as outlined in Section F (page 13) of the AO. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order. EPA will consider removing the boil water order once testing of the new well is complete, the old (existing well) is plugged and abandoned, and the Wyoming DEQ has conducted a final inspection and approved the new well and public water system modifications.
