## ORDER DIRECTING REGIONAL HEARING CLERK TO FORWARD CASE TO CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

This is an administrative action alleging that Respondents Mardaph II, LLC, Mardaph III, LLC, and Vinnie Wilson violated the Toxic Substances Control Act ("TSCA") in failing to provide its lessees with the required disclosures regarding the possible presence of lead paint at the rental units. The record in this matter reflects that Vinnie Wilson is the President of Mardaph II and Mardaph III. She is appearing in this matter *pro se*.

Complainant previously moved for entry of a default order against Respondent Wilson. That motion, however, was denied and Ms. Wilson has filed an answer. Complainant then moved for entry of a default order against Respondents Mardaph II, LLC, and Mardaph III, LLC, for their failure to file an answer in this matter.

Respondents Mardaph II and III have filed responses to Complainant's motion and the Presiding Officer's Order to Show Cause dated July 1, 2009. Neither of these responses was denominated as an answer. Each response, however, does contain denials of the allegations contained in the Complaint.<sup>2</sup> Respondents appear to dispute the proposed penalty, as Ms. Wilson has submitted copies of her tax returns. Finally, the response dated July 23, 2009, appears to request a hearing.<sup>3</sup>

Given Ms. Wilson's *pro se* status, and her apparent denial of the allegations contained in the Complaint, I am construing the Mardaph responses as an answer for purposes of Consolidated Rule 22.21(a). 40 C.F.R. § 22.21(a). I hereby direct the
