ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

As stated in my *Order Staying Proceeding* dated May 16, 2012, a *Third Order to File Joint Status Report* was issued on April 4, 2012, directing the parties to file a Status Report no later than April 20, 2012. A *Status Report* dated May 11, 2012 was sent to the Undersigned electronically by Complainant's Attorney, stating that Complainant was filing a motion to withdraw this matter. My May 16th *Order* directed the Complainant to file a motion to withdraw, or in the alternative, file a status report by June 1, 2012.

To date, I have not received any motions or status reports in response to my May 16, 2012 *Order*. In light of the considerations set forth herein, the Undersigned issues the following **ORDER**.

IT IS ORDERED:


