#### **COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT RECORD**

COMES NOW the Complainant, Director of the Clean Water Protection Division of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 4, and provides the attached documents as supplements to the record filed in this case. On January 15, 2015, in response to the Regional Judicial Officer's (RJO) Order to Supplement the Record, dated October 29, 2014, Complainant provided the Declaration of Mike Wylie, which provides the factual grounds for the proposed penalty in this case, together with the documents Mr. Wylie relied on in his calculation of that penalty. Complainant inadvertently failed to include a copy of a letter to the Respondents notifying them that enforcement of this case was referred to the EPA, cited in Mr. Wylie's declaration as Exhibit E. A copy of that letter is attached to this pleading as Exhibit A. Also attached are documents which served as the basis for the referral, as follows: a Violation Analysis prepared by the Army Corps of Engineers (Exhibit B), and an email from the Army Corps of Engineers asking that a violation number be assigned to this case (Exhibit C),

Complainant respectfully requests that the RJO supplement the record with the attached exhibits and, considering the entire record in this case, find that default has occurred, issue a default order against the defaulting party as to all parts of the proceeding, and issue an Order for Default and \$157,500 civil penalty against Respondents.


