This Letter of Remittance Upon Satisfaction of Settlement Conditions is issued in accordance with the Consent Agreement, Final Order ("CA/FO") and Settlement Conditions? Document ("SCD") filed June 24, 2009 in settlement of a Complaint issued against Tony J. Papadimitriou ("Respondent") on December 31, 2007. The Complaint was filed pursuant to Section 16(a) of the Toxic Substances Control Act and the Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties and the Revocation/ Termination or Suspension of Permits ("Consolidated Rules of Practice") set forth at 40 C.F.R. Part 22.

The CA/FO required, among other things, the expenditure of \$72,000.00 by Respondent for the Supplemental Environmental Project ("SEP"). After a review of the receipts submitted by Respondent, EPA determined that the allowable expenditures totaled \$65,034.14. Pursuant to Paragraph 31.d. of the CA/FO, Respondent will not be subjected to Stipulated Penalties as the allowable amount of the SEP expenditure is within 90% of the SEP expenditure target amount. Pursuant to Section VI of the SCAFO, EPA issues this Letter of Remittance Upon Satisfaction of Settlement Conditions acknowledging that Respondent has complied substantially with all the terms and conditions set forth in the CA/FO and SCD.
