BACKGROUND

A Motion for an Extension of Time to File an Answer may be granted upon the timely

filing of such motion, a showing of good cause, and after consideration of prejudice to other

parties to the action. 40 C.F.R. §§ 22.7(b); 22.16. This motion is timely and has been filed before

the date for Respondent's Answer to the Complaint. This motion also satisfies the "good cause"

requirement because granting this Motion will allow both Respondent and Complainant to

identify and obtain the additional information both parties require in order to continue mutually

acceptable settlement discussions. Lastly, granting this Motion will not result in prejudice to any

other party to this action. As stated herein, both parties are currently involved in settlement

discussions and the granting of this Motion will allow both parties more time to fully resolve this

matter.

CONCLUSION

For the reasons set forth above, Respondent respectfully requests that the Presiding

Officer grant Respondent's request for a sixty (60) day extension of time to answer or otherwise

respond in the above captioned matter.
