## MOTION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUBPOENAS

COMES NOW the Respondent, by and through counsel, and moves for the issuance of subpoenas to command that the following witnesses appear at the hearing currently scheduled in this matter during the week of May 3, 2004, or at such other date and time agreed upon between counsel and said witnesses.

This motion is made pursuant to  $\S309(g)(10)$  of the Clean Water Act, 33 USC 1319(g)(10), and 40 CFR 22.21(b). 40 CFR 22.21(b) states in part:

(b) Notice of Hearing. . . The Presiding Officer may require the attendance of witnesses or the production of documentary evidence by subpoena, if authorized under the Act, upon a showing of the grounds and necessity therefor, and the materiality and relevancy of the evidence to be adduced.

The Respondent intends to call several witnesses who are currently employed by the State of Alaska. The state is requiring subpoenas for the attendance of its employees at this hearing in order to justify their time away from their jobs. Two witnesses, Jeff Graham, and Allan Moore, work outside the Kenai/Soldotna area

and will be provided roundtrip travel to attend the hearing. Therefore, Respondent requests that the Presiding Officer issue the enclosed subpoenas for the attendance of Jeff Graham, Al Peterson, Allan Moore, and Jeff Fox.

## Summary of Testimony

Jeff Graham is employed by the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, in the Division of Forestry. Mr. Graham was the Resource Advisor for the Alaska Department of Forestry Forest Stewardship Program. He will testify that in June 1998 he traveled to the Blossom property and drove around the property. He will testify of his observations of Mr. Blossom's ongoing silviculture activities, including timber cutting and slash piles. After his inspection of the property, a Forestry Stewardship Plan was issued to Mr. Blossom which Mr. Graham signed.

Al Peterson works as the Natural Resources Advisor for the State Department of Forestry. He will testify that on February 21, 2001, he wrote and issued a Forestry Stewardship Program that both he and Mr. Blossom signed in April 2001. He will testify that silviculture includes site preparation, planting of seedlings, growing, and harvesting trees, and that Mr. Blossom has been doing silviculture on his lands for years before 2001.

Allan Moore is the Head Construction Engineer for the State of Alaska Department of Transportation. He will testify about the construction of the culvert running under the Sterling Hwy. near Mr. Blossom's property.

Jeff Fox works for the State of Alaska, Department of Fish & Game. He will testify about the nature and biological
